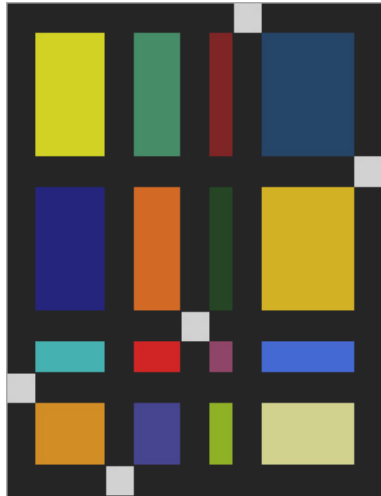

- develop collaborative programs and resource sharing to enhance quality and reduce individual and collective operating and capital costs.

Library Resources

Important library resources available to you are CONSORT, the “Ohio Five” system, and OhioLINK, the state-wide academic system.

CONSORT, established in 1995, merged the library catalogs of Denison, Kenyon, Ohio Wesleyan, and Wooster. Local library users enter online requests for materials from other CONSORT and OhioLINK institutions. OhioLINK’s delivery service transports requested materials to the borrower’s campus.

Introductions to Peers

Building connections to others in your discipline or in similar administrative positions can be a great source of support and professional development. Recent activities have included

- an annual speakers’ exchange in Mathematics and Physics,
- a video-conferenced *Pathogens* seminar for biology faculty, and
- emergency preparedness meetings for communications, IT, safety, and student-life staff.
